<p>Lates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students who are late for their exam are to sign in at the office. <p>Absences:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unauthorized absence from an examination will result in an exam mark of 0%. Absence due to illness or extenuating circumstances must be communicated immediately to the Vice-Principal. Medical certificates or other documentation will be required. Teachers will not make arrangements for missed exams. Please see the VP. Scheduling of eLearning exams must be scheduled with the VP. <p>Inclement Weather:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the event that the school is closed, the exams originally scheduled for that day will be written on the next day back to school. The sequence of exams will not be changed. Parents/Students should visit the school's website, listen to the radio, if they suspect a school closure. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the event that buses are cancelled and the school remains open, exams will proceed as scheduled. Students who take the bus will write the exam they missed in the afternoon (12:00 PM) of the following day. This means they will write two exams on that day: regularly scheduled exam in the morning and missed exam in the afternoon. <p>Exam-Free Days:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students do not have to come to school when they don't have scheduled exams. <p>Conflicts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teachers are not able to reschedule exams for students. If students have any issues concerning the exam schedule, they should be directed to the Vice-Principal for resolution. Family vacations, appointments, and work duties are not to be scheduled during the exam period. 	<p>Personal Electronic Devices (PED's):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Absolutely no electronic devices (Iphones, I pads, etc.) are allowed in the exam rooms unless authorized by the supervising teacher. Having a PED could result in a mark of zero on the exam. <p>Textbooks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Course textbooks must be returned by the day of the exam. <p>Hallways:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hallways are out of bounds during exams. <p>Cafeteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No food services will be available during the exam period. The cafeteria is available for study purposes only. <p>Library:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The library will be open for quiet study from 9:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. <p>Resource Room:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students writing exams in Resource will be contacted by their resource teacher. <p>Buses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Buses will arrive and depart at the regular times. 	

- **Semi Formal Dance – ‘Under the Volcano’**

The South Semi Formal Dance will be held on February 27th from 7-9pm in the South Cafeteria. ‘Under the Volcano’ is the theme. Ticket sales will close on February 24th and are only available online, no cash sales. Guests are welcome and must be accompanied by a South student when entering the dance. Guests must fill out a Guest Pass (available in the main office) and have it signed by the Vice-Principal at South and the Vice-Principal at the Guest's school. The Guest Pass must be returned to the school by February 21st including the guest parent signature and information. Two tickets are available for payment per student so they can pay for the guest ticket. Proceeds go to Student Council activities/projects.
